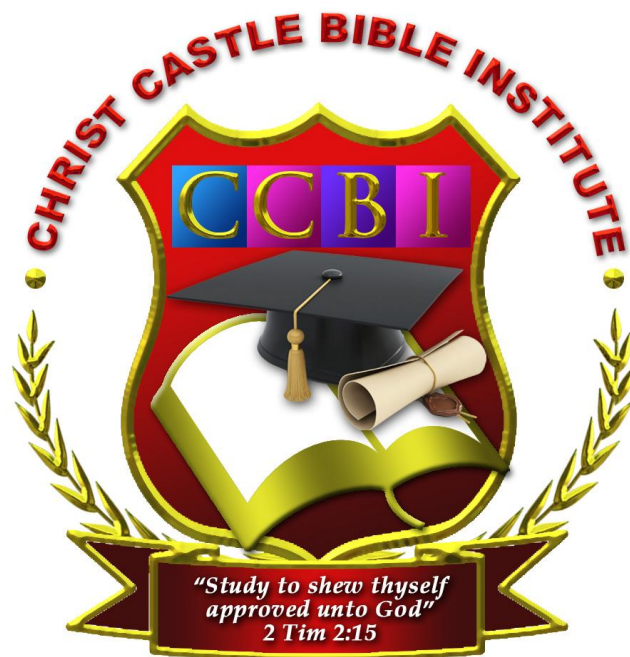

Statement of Faith

We believe:

- 1 In the one true and living God, the creator of heaven and earth who is revealed to us as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit;
- 2 Christ is divine, the Lord and Saviour without who we cannot be saved (Acts 4:12)
- 3 Christ was born of the Virgin Mary (Luke 1:26-28)
- 4 All Scripture is given by "inspiration of God" (2 Timothy 3:16) and holy men of God "were moved by the Holy Spirit" (2 Peter 1:21)
- 5 In the holy Spirit the divine Comforter (John 14:16, 15:26)
- 6 Until His second coming all Christians have duties to make sure that the great commission is fulfilled (Matthew 28:18-20)
- 7 Salvation is a gift of God's grace and not by works (John 1:12; Romans 10:9-10; Ephesians 2:8)
- 8 In baptism by immersion (Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11)
- 9 In regeneration and the new birth through the acceptance of the gospel (John 3:1-7; 2 Corinthians 5:17)
- 10 The immortality and eternal life are gifts of God and received through Jesus Christ (Romans 6:23; John 3:16)
- 11 There will be resurrection of the dead (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17)
- 12 The just shall live by faith (Habakkuk 2:4; Romans 1:17)
- 13 In the support of the gospel through tithe and offering Leviticus 27:30, 32; Malachi 3:8-12)
- 14 In the ordinance of humility and the Lord's last supper (John 13:4-17; 1 Corinthians 11:23-30)
- 15 In the gift of the Holy Spirit (1 Corinthians 12; Ephesians 4:11-12); and the fruits of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- 16 In discarding all immoral, unhealthy and unspiritual practices including narcotics, intoxicants, tobacco etc (Proverbs 20:1, 21:17, 23:20-21, 29-35; Isaiah 5:11; 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; Ephesians 5:18)

STUDY PROGRAMME FOR 2015

Level 1 - Certificate in Christian Ministry

This course lasts for one year and is aimed at new Christians or those who have not undertaken formal religious or Bible studies previously.

The academic year for the Certificate course runs from Tuesday 13th January through to 1st December 2015.

This course requires a minimum of 2 hours study every week. It takes place every Tuesday evening between 7-9pm and is split over three terms (each lasting 12 weeks).

Syllabus:

The three core modules are as follows:

Foundation in Christian Education: 13th January to 31st March

- One Body in Christ (The Church)
- Sin as a Choice
- The Word Became flesh
- Understanding Salvation
- Living in the Spirit
- Righteousness (Your new life in Christ)
- Abraham: An example of Righteousness
- Justification, Sanctification & Glorification
- Leading Souls to Christ

Foundation in Prophetic Ministry: 5th May to 21st July

- Understanding Prophecy
- An Old Testament Perspective
- New Testament Dispensation
- Spiritual Gifting
- Battling in the Spiritual Realm
- Tares Among the Wheat
- Qualities of a True Prophet
- Prophetic Evangelism
- Blessings of the Prophetic Gift

Foundation in Christian Ministry: 15th September to 1st December

- Understanding the Bible
- How to Really Study the Bible
- Introduction to Church History
- Understanding Worship
- Perspectives on Prayer
- Building Christian Character
- Christian Ethics
- The Authority of a Believer
- Sharing our Faith

Assessment:

Assessment is via two test papers each term, covering the materials taught during lectures. A pass mark of 60% is required to graduate, as well as an attendance record of at least 80%.

Entry Requirements:

There are no formal entry requirements but student must be committed and enjoy the word. It is open to anyone who is about 16 years and above.

Cost:

The overall fee for the course is £60. This can be paid as £20 each term not later than one week before the commencement date of term.

Level 2 - Diploma in Applied Spirituality

This course runs for two years and is aimed at Christian students who already have a basic level of religious education and are interested in personal spiritual growth.

The Diploma is modelled on the course available from the **Christian Leadership University's School of Spirit** (a private University in the United States). We have been permitted and authorised to you their syllabus.

Completion of the course is a prelude to the award of a degree for those who want to further their religious education.

This course requires a minimum of 5 hours study every week. It takes place on the second and fourth Saturday of every month between 1-5pm and is split over three terms (each lasting 12 weeks).

Syllabus:

There are four modules spread over the two years.

- Knowing God Through the Word
- Living In The Spirit
- Empowered By The Spirit
- Dynamic Physical Health

The 1st academic year for the Diploma runs from Saturday 10 January 2015 through to 28 November 2015. The syllabus for 2015 covers the following topics in each module:

Living In The Spirit (1): 10th January to 21st March 2015

- Hearing God's Voice
- Counseled by God
- Prayers that Heal the Heart

Knowing God Through the Word (1): 9th May to 25th July 2015

- Pentateuch
- History 1 - United Kingdom
- History 2 - Divided Kingdom

Living In The Spirit (2): 12th September to 24th October 2015

- Hear God Through Your Dreams
- Living Naturally Supernatural
- How to Walk by the Spirit

Empowered By The Spirit: 14th to 28th November 2015

- How to Have Mountain Moving Faith
- Divine Healing Toolbox
- How to Receive the Baptism in the Holy Spirit
- How to Build a Winning Team

The 2nd academic year for the Diploma runs from Saturday 9 January 2015 through to 26 November 2016. The syllabus for 2016 covers the following topics in each module:

Knowing God Through the Word (2): 9th January to 26th March 2016

- Major Prophets
- Life of Christ

Living In The Spirit (3): 14th May to 11th June 2016

- Parenting by Grace
- How to be a Spirit-Anointed Communicator

Dynamic Physical Health: 25th June to 23rd July 2016

- Take Charge of Your Health

Knowing God Through the Word (3): 10th September to 26th November 2016

- Acts and Epistles
- Epistles and Revelation

Assessment:

Assessment is via application exercises each week, where students will demonstrate seeing, writing, practising, sharing and reflecting the revelation-based learning method.

A pass mark of 60% is required to graduate, as well as an attendance record of at least 80%.

Entry Requirements:

You must have completed and graduated from the Certificate in Christian Ministry or its equivalent. It is open to anyone who is about 16 years and above.

Cost:

The overall fee for the course is £90. This can be paid as £30 each term not later than one week before the commencement date of term.
